


APPROVED DEVICE CERTIFICATION




A vital service for those taking on the challenge of traffic enforcement.

The introduction of part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 has brought both great opportunities and serious challenges.

On the one hand, local authorities can now take on traffic enforcement, giving real opportunities to reduce the impact of traffic congestion on the environment by shaping traffic flow and also reducing accident levels. On the other hand, the new powers are leavened with a massive system management burden – Approved Device Certification – which necessitates the collation and assessment of every item in the information chain, on an on-going basis.

APPROVED DEVICE CERTIFICATION

Under part 6 of the Traffic Management Act 2004, every element in the chain used to collect and process enforcement information, from the camera lens to adjudication, must undergo a rigorous Approved Device Certification process.

Cognetix took part in the consultation process for this legislation and were one of the partners in its first implementation, so we are ideally placed to manage the entire certification process for our clients, creating the Technical Construction File for their system and advising on any deficiencies and remedial works where necessary.

Creating the Technical Construction File involves:

- Reviewing all available system documentation, such as the O&M manuals, the FATs/SATs, design specifications and maintenance records.
- A technical audit of all current infrastructure.
- System testing to ensure compliance.

All of this information will be collated in the correct form and submitted to the DfT for certification. Cognetix will manage this process and liaise with the DfT on behalf of our clients.

The Technical Construction File, however, is a living document and any subsequent changes made to the system will need to be reflected in it and may well require complete re-certification of the entire system in order for any enforcement to remain legal. Cognetix can manage this through a comprehensive Change Control process, tracking and investigating changes to ensure that the whole system remains compliant at all times.
